
Accreditations

On January 31, 2012, Walsh Electric was granted a Women's Business Enterprise (WBE) certification by the New York State Department of Economic Development. The first quarter of 2012 proved to be quite a busy one. We recently completed the Joe Fresh Flagship store for Richter and Ratner on 5th Ave in conjunction with all of the landlord work for Sweet Construction, a major service upgrade for Major League Baseball at 692 Broadway, a trading floor at Suntrust Bank for Structur-etone, a Northfield Bank branch in Borough Park, Brooklyn for The Eagle Group, as well as The International Union of Operating Engineers Headquarters in Long Island City for Sweet Construction. At the Staten Island Mall, we have completed a shadow metering project for the landlord as well as an entire upgrade of the building HVAC system with Havel as the project management firm and Nasco as the HVAC contractor.
